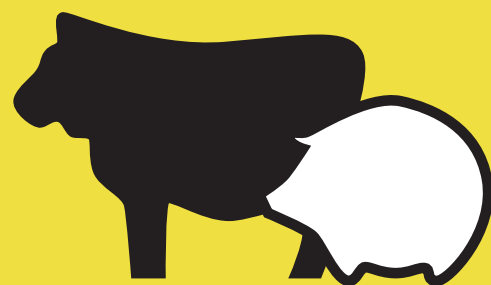
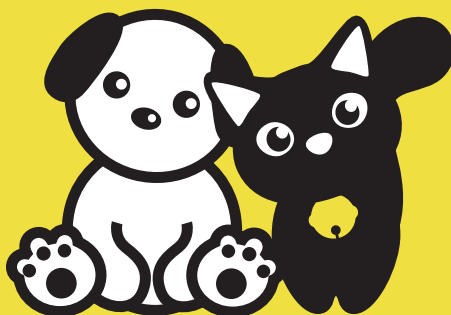


Taking Meat Products Out of Japan



Under Japanese laws and regulations, some items **must be inspected by the Animal Quarantine Service** before being taken out of Japan, and some items are **prohibited from being taken to overseas** destinations such as China and Korea.



Examples of items requiring animal quarantine

Beef, pork, chicken, eggs

Items for which export conditions have been agreed with the importing country, or for which an Animal Quarantine Certificate is required



Food products and livestock products derived from wild animals



Livestock semen and fertilized eggs (embryos)



Live livestock and pets (dogs and cats)



※ In addition to the above, other items may also require animal quarantine.



Exporting items without inspection by the Animal Quarantine Service is subject to legal penalties (up to 3 years' imprisonment or a fine of up to 3 million yen).
