Hon.Dr. Thomas J. VILSACK (Secretary of Agriculture, United States of America)

Vilsack was confirmed as the 32nd U.S. Secretary of Agriculture under President Biden to return to a role where he served for eight years under President Barack Obama. Prior to returning to USDA, he served as president and CEO of the U.S. Dairy Export Council. He also served two terms as the Governor of Iowa, served in the Iowa State Senate and as the mayor of Mt. Pleasant, Iowa.



Mr. Sebastien BOUVATIER (Deputy head, the Environmental Performance Division at the Ministry of Agriculture, Agrifood and Forestry in France)

Mr. Sébastien Bouvatier is an agronomy and forestry engineer by training. He currently works as Deputy Head of the Environmental Performance Division at the Ministry of Agriculture, Agrifood and Forestry in France, for all topics related to agriculture/environment, as well as agricultural land management regulations and extension services provided to farmers to facilitate their agroecological transition.
