

3. Outline of results

- (1) Approximately 90 people participated in this meeting from government agencies and agriculture-related companies from both countries, and the status of Japanese efforts for reconstruction in Ukraine's agricultural sector in 2024 were shared in the meeting.
- (2) MAFF explained the activities being implemented under the collaboration with private sectors by the attached file, and five Japanese private companies (Maekawa MFG.CO., LTD, Mebiol Inc, Kakuichi.CO., LTD., NTC International CO.,Ltd., and AC Biode Co.,Ltd.) reported on their initiatives (online and on-site seminars, invitations of Ukrainian officials, on-site surveys, etc.) and future plans.
- (3) MAPF explained Ukraine's agricultural policy, etc., and welcomed that in 2024 there was a major step forward with the conclusion of Memoranda of Cooperation between both ministries and private companies. MAPF also stated that they would like to utilize Japanese technologies and experiences to realize much efficient agriculture for the economic growth in Ukraine.






