

Implement cooperative projects utilizing Japan's accumulated technologies to build a robust and sustainable agriculture and food system through innovation in the ASEAN region.



Global MIDORI Cooperation Plan (2024.12) Develop Tailor-made cooperation based on the experience gained in ASEAN, because the natural and social conditions of the agriculture, forestry, and fisheries industries vary widely.

- · Close cooperation with the developing countries and taking into account regional characteristics.
- Three basic principles as follow
- (1) agricultural sustainability should be improved in the direction of higher productivity
- (2) food system should be strengthened by making maximum use of existing domestic agricultural resources
- (3) all forms of innovation should be used
- In addition to the private sector, promote initiatives in **collaboration with** industry, academia, government, and finance,, and financial institutions, and **international organizations such as FAO, WFP, and IFAD**.
