Overview of Export Production Areas

Production of grapes, collection from own and neighboring producers, sorting and packing (operation of own sorting facility), and shipment to domestic and international markets.

Actions for Compliance with Export Regulations

For exports to Taiwan, large bunches of grapes are shipped according to local needs. Additionally, a new vineyard has been established in Ibaraki Prefecture, where pesticide use is minimized, to strengthen exports to Taiwan. Compliance with plant quarantine certification, pesticide residue standards (for Taiwan), and registration of production areas and sorting/packing facilities, as well as pesticide residue standards (for Thailand).

Promotional Points

The CEO has received the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries' "Excellent Exporter Award (Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries Award)" and is a GFP Ambassador. Furthermore, by collaborating with multiple producers, the company leads the export of Japanese grapes and promotes the development of advanced export regions.
