

### III Statistical Tables

#### Notes

- 1 Unless otherwise stated, all figures are national statistics.  
However, in the case of figures in the scale stratification by the area of cultivated land under management, those of Hokkaido and the rest of the Prefectures are separately compiled.  
The reasons for this measure are that, in a territory of long north-south axis, Japan' s agricultural contents vary especially in Hokkaido and average cropland area in Hokkaido is 10-fold greater than that in the rest of Japan that the two parts of Japan in question cannot be considered comparable.
- 2 Symbols used are as follows:  
“0” is that number that does not attain the unit  
“-” is where there is no data  
“...” is where data are unavailable or not surveyed
- 3 The sum of areas may not agree with its contents because of errors in rounding at the decimal point.
