② Farmer's market: Minacoicoiya

A spacious market is brimming with fresh morning-harvested vegetables, and also offers Awajishima onions, Awaji beef, fresh dairy products, and fresh seafood directly delivered from the fishing port, showcasing a variety of the island's seasonal foods. "Shukakushokusai" restaurant on the 2nd floor also offers dishes made with local ingredients.

④ Uzu no Oka Onaruto Bridge Memorial Hall

This building on a hill in the southwestern part of Awaji Island opened in 1985, the same year as the opening of the Onaruto Bridge. It promotes Awaji Island with onion-themed

attractions such as the Onion Catcher, the giant onion statue called "Ottamanegi", and onion wigs.

⑤ Onion Hut

Onion huts scattered throughout Minamiawaji City are facilities that use "Tsuru-dama", a traditional drying and storage technique using natural wind. Some onion huts use Awaji roof tiles, a unique local industry product.

① Awaji Farm Park England Hill

A farm park where visitors can enjoy seasonal flowers all year round and experience harvesting of fresh vegetables and fruits in season. Awaji onion harvesting experience is available from mid-March to early June.
