While savoring the supreme ingredients natured by the rich nature, fully enjoy the charms of Japan.



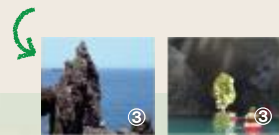
Day1

- 9:00 Depart from Kyoto Station
- 11:15 ① Amanohashidate View Land (lunch)
- 13:30 ② Kehara Rice Terraces
- 15:45 ③ Kiriham Beach (San'in Kaigan UNESCO Global Geopark)
- 17:45 ④ Kokoro no Sato Kai (accommodation) or ⑤ Minshuku Kyubee (accommodation)

② Kehara Rice Terraces

Many splendid landscapes remain, including approx. 600 Rice Terraces, traditional thatched-roof houses, and other settings maintained with the geographical conditions.

③ Kiriham Beach

From the beach, you can see "Hasakari Rock" (prefectural designated scenic spot) and "Yodo Cave" recognized as major tourist spots of "San'in Kaigan UNESCO Global Geopark".

④ Kokoro no Sato Kai

A traditional inn renovated from a 150-old sericulture farmhouse.

⑥ Hyogo Prefectural Tajima Pasture Park

This pasture park serves as a hub for promotion and production of the world-renowned brand from Hyogo, "Tajima cattle", as well as a place for visitors to interact with animals such as Tajima cattle, sheep, goats and the natural surroundings. Also, the park has the Tajima Cattle Museum where you can learn the history and characteristics of Tajima cattle.

⑦ Ueyama Rice Terraces

Ueyama Rice Terraces was selected as one of the "100 best Rice Terraces in Japan". Everyone will be captivated by the splendid scenery spread across the mountains, and feel compelled to take photos of this beautiful landscapes of Japan.

① Amanohashidate View Land

Observatory, located on top of the Mount Monju, offers a panoramic view of Amanohashidate from the south side. The upside down view from between your legs ("Matano-zoki") from this platform is called "Flying Dragon View" as Amanohashidate looks like a dragon flying in the sky.

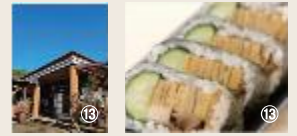
⑬ Meister Kobo Yachiyo

⑫ Isarigami Rice Terraces

Isarigami is a small village located deep in the mountains of Northern Harima, in the center of Hyogo Prefecture. The beautiful stone-walled Rice Terraces in Isarigami have been selected as one of the "100 Best Rice Terraces in Japan".

⑨ Takeda Castle Ruins

From September to December each year, "Sea of Clouds", the indispensable settings for the Castle in the Sky, are formed. A mystical scene that you have never seen before is created around the castle.

⑧ Takeda Castle Town Hotel EN

Featuring the main house which has been directly renovated, the approx. 400-year-old "former Kimura Sake Brewery" building, and the detached houses that were built over 100 years ago during the Meiji period, the six buildings in total nestled beneath the "Castle in the Sky", Takeda Castle.
