




Miyazaki Production area of Sagahonoka

The vast land area stretching 600 km from north to south, which includes Sakurajima, one of the world's most active volcanoes, and the World Natural Heritage sites of Yakushima, Amami Oshima, and Tokunoshima, produces many of Japan's best products, including wagyu beef, Kurobuta pork, cultured yellowtail and kampachi (yellowtail and amberjack), and sweet potatoes. The prefecture also boasts unique products such as authentic shochu (Japanese liquor) and Oshima silk, as well as a wide variety of hot springs. Kagoshima tea is also famous.

Amaou ®

(The meanings of the initials of "akai," "marui," "ookii", and "umai.")



Characteristics: Everyone knows the king of strawberries. The fruit is large and round in the shape of a cone. It is characterized by its deep red color, and its flesh is hard and juicy. It's very flavorful and sweet and sour are harmonious. It is grown only in Fukuoka Prefecture.

Ichigo-san ®

(The meaning is that they want to be loved for a long time)



Characteristics: Enchanted and beautiful cone shape with deep red skin. Even the flesh turns red. It has a fresh aroma and gorgeous sweetness and is juicy and full of juice.

Yumenoka

(Delicious strawberries that make everyone's dreams come true)



Characteristics: The fruit is large and conical. The flesh is moderately hard and juicy. The sweetness and sourness harmonize well, and you can enjoy the sweet and sour taste. It also goes well with fresh cream. It is mostly produced in Nagasaki Prefecture.

Sagahonoka (Meaning the beauty

(Meaning the beauty and heart of Saga)



Characteristics: It is a very famous variety. It has a nice cone shape. It is characterized by slightly hard and white pulp. The acidity is mild and sweet. The sweet smell is very strong. Licca-chan served as a billboard from 2007 to 2020.

Koi Minori

(The meaning is that the wishes entrusted through strawberries will be fulfilled with high yield.)



Characteristics: The fruit is slightly round and the fruit weight is large. The skin is bright red and shiny, and the flesh is white. The fragrance is rich, and the sweetness and sourness are harmonious. It keeps well. It is mostly produced in Nagasaki Prefecture.

Youbeni

(Meaning bear reading 'you' and bright red skin 'beni').



Characteristics: The fruit is large and conical in shape. The skin is shiny and bright red, and the inside of the flesh is red. It is hard, fresh and has a good balance of sweetness and sourness. It has a rich taste. The bright red color goes well with cakes.

Berryts ®

(Meaning strawberry like sweets)



Characteristics: Oita Prefecture spent eight years developing it. Vivid red color and gloss. Fruit juice overflows with a rich aroma. High sugar content and a good balance of sweetness and acidity. Exports are small and rare. Please come to Oita and eat it.

Hinoshizuku

(Meaning fresh strawberries from Kumamoto with clean water)



Characteristics: It took 8 years to develop. It's a round shape. It is characterized by hard, white to pale pink flesh. It has less acidity and elegant sweetness. You can enjoy a very strong fragrance.

Awayuki (Meaning a light layer of snow)

Characteristics: Raised by the Yamashita family in Kagoshima Prefecture.

The sourness is moderate and the sweetness is strong. It has a light taste and the gentle fragrance of white strawberries spreads.

The pericarp is white, but the seeds are red. It's very rare.

Satsumaotome

(Meaning a young woman from the western part of Kagoshima)



Characteristics: The fruit is large and bright red and shiny, and the inside is white. It has less acidity, high sugar content and accentuates sweetness, and is characterized by peach-like aroma and flavor.

It's a difficult variety to grow. It is grown only in Kagoshima prefecture.

Pika Ichigo ®

(It means "picaichi" strawberry that tastes good and looks good.)



Characteristics: The fruit is conical. You can enjoy the consistent sweetness throughout the season. Refreshing and tasty. It is beautifully colored without unevenness and looks good. It is grown only in Kagoshima prefecture.
