- **6. Description of content:** To prevent the introduction of *X. fastidiosa* into Japan, MAFF has taken emergency measures for the host plants of *X. fastidiosa* from Colombia. The measures are taken as follows:
  - For live plants and plant parts for planting (excluding seeds and fruits), the plants randomly taken from a lot and plants with suspected symptoms are tested during leafing stage by an appropriate serological diagnosis method such as ELISA or an appropriate genetic method such as PCR assay and found to be free from Xylella fastidiosa.
  - In addition, National Plant Protection Organizations (NPPO) of Colombia will be required to include an additional declaration stating that "Fulfills item 23 of the Annexed Table 2-2 of the Ordinance for Enforcement of the Plant Protection Act (MAF Ordinance No. 73/1950)."

Regarding the host plants of *Xylella fastidiosa*, further details are provided in the document attached.

- 7. Objective and rationale: [ ] food safety, [ ] animal health, [X] plant protection, [ ] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [ ] protect territory from other damage from pests.
- **8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action:** MAFF has stipulated *Xylella fastidiosa* as one of the important quarantine pests for Japan. To prevent the entry of *X. fastidiosa* into Japan, an additional declaration should be included in the phytosanitary certificate for the import of host plants of *X. fastidiosa* originated in Colombia. This is an urgent action taken prior to the revision of the Ordinance for Enforcement of the Plant Protection Act, based on the newly confirmed information regarding the presence of *X. fastidiosa* in Colombia.
